June 21. Henschel began working for me today.

June 27 →

June 29. Curfew imposed suddenly last night from 9 P.M. to 6 A.M. this morning. Reason, I guess, were fears of disturbances because of death-penalty to be imposed today on a young Jew for carrying arms. Our dinner party had to disperse hurriedly.

Frau ~~Pate~~ Stahl died ^{day before} yesterday at age of 85^(?). When Sheikh came to Mrs. Einder to bring the school's two pound monthly pension, he was told that Mrs. Einder had died.
