- June 21. Herschel began working for me today.
- Sheikh Khalil al-Khalidi called on me.
- June 23. Went to A.P.S. Clark's for dinner with Helen. Among those present were Bertha Novomensky, Captain and Mrs. Norton, & Mrs. & Mrs. Moody.
- The School is practically empty. Pike & Fisher are leaving on the 29th for Grecia, leaving on Petrie, Wambold, & Winetts here.

- June 29. Curfew imposed suddenly last night from 9 P.M. to 6 A.M. this morning. Reason, I guess, were fears of disturbances because of death-penalty to be imposed today on a young Jew for carrying arms. Our dinner party had to disperse hurriedly.
- Franziska Stahel died ^{day before} June 27 at age of 85^(?). When Shukri came to Mrs. Einster to bring the school's two pound monthly pension, he was told that Mrs. Einster had died.
- Am 27. Juni starb in Sarona im Alterheim, wo sie seit 1 Jahr lebte die vermietete Frau Anna Stahel, geb. Mayer aus Steinbach bei Schwäbisch-Hall im 85. Lebensjahr.
- July 4. Returned from Haifa & Tel-Aviv where we went to meet Eleanor Brady, Sally, & P. Brady. Curfew again tonight.
