A.M. Shot at bent around our property turning from Salah-ad-Din road to road going to Museum at Nekra taxi carrying P.W.D. Jewish workmen to Museum.

P.M. Shot very near the same place; do not yet know what the shooting was about.

Two heads found in sack on Damascus gate last night; belonged to two Moroccans, who had been captured in Jericho by bands, their bodies found near Tel Karem, & now their heads on Damascus gate.

Oct. 17. Curfew on old city, which bands practically hold. Continuous shooting practically from and around walls of old city.

Arab school-children sent back home this morning.

Yesterday kids blocked narrow dock of our school on way to Museum.

Oct. 17. Ilfis left after lunch. Marjorie Ilfis, David, & the nurse were here for lunch.

Oct. 18. Curfew in Old City now for two days

Airplanes flying round & round over the old City. Constant machine-guns & rifle fire. Machine-guns and signal-signal ~~on~~ on Museum Tower; very lights. Impossible to buy vegetables or meat, eggs etc. from normal sources of supply.

Oct. 19. Planes began flying at dawn this morning.

Pamphlets dropped by planes all over Old City & immediate surroundings causing people to stay inside their houses.

Ilfis & other English evacuated from behind us near Wadi Jis & have gone to G.M.C.A.

I went to Mesh Sharim to buy vegetable, because servants afraid to go out and patronize & closed Arab shops recently, after all the shootings of yesterday, & the ~~very~~ lights, some of the bands escaped last night & kidnapped ^{bringing} over ^{the} ^{shooting} ^{governor} ^{to} ^{the} ^{gate} ^{of} ^{the} ^{city} ^{from} ^{the} ^{front} ^{gate} ^{of} ^{the} ^{city} ^{than} ^{the} ^{English}
