Members of the Jerusalem School Committee:

At Professor Cadbury's request I am sending you this communication. You will find enclosed a card addressed to Prof. Cadbury for an expression of your judgment on the following question:

Professor Gvid B. Sellers can get leave-of-absence from McCormick Theological Seminary for the year 1948-49. It has been suggested (not by him) that he would be an admirable Annual Professor for the Jerusalem School. Ordinarily we should not make an appointment so far in advance, but Professor Sellers would have the special advantage of being competent to act as Director of the School in case Dr. Glueck should be unable to return for that year. I therefore recommend that we appoint Professor Sellers as Annual Professor for 1948-49, with the understanding that he can serve as Director or Acting Director if necessary.

In order that Professor Cadbury may report the judgment of the Jerusalem School committee, please let him know promptly how you feel about it.
